On 6th February this year Her Majesty The Queen became the first British Monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee, marking 70 years of service to the people of the United Kingdom, the Realms and the Commonwealth.

A special extended bank holiday weekend will provide an opportunity for communities and people throughout the United Kingdom to come together to celebrate the historic milestone.

Platinum Jubilee Beacons

A beacon chain, once used as a tool for communication, has now become a symbol of unity and over 1,500 beacons will be lit throughout the United Kingdom, Channel Islands, Isle of Man and UK Overseas Territories

In 1897, beacons were lit to celebrate Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee. In 1977, 2002 and 2012, beacons commemorated the Queen's Silver, Golden and Diamond Jubilees and in 2016 Her Majesty's 90th birthday



The lighting of Knapton's beacon at 9:45pm on Thursday, at the same time as hundreds of others are lit across Norfolk, will be the central point of focus for our parish's outdoor celebrations

Seating

We are hoping that every resident of the parish will join us to celebrate and although there will be seating at all events, it will be limited so you may want to consider bringing a lightweight camping chair or similar or maybe a blanket if you're planning to have a picnic on the grass

Toilets

There is a toilet just inside the church which will be available during all events on Thursday, Friday and Saturday

Glasses and Drinking Vessels

In keeping with our Green policy we expect to have re-usable cups for the children to use at all events, but should you prefer to bring your own, that would be fine. Adults should bring along their own drinking vessel (but not glass please) if possible just in case we run out

Complementary Voucher

This voucher entitles each Knapton resident to a free **BBQ meal** at the BBQ Street Party event on 2nd June

BBQ

The BBQ will be available at the entrance to the church from 7pm until around 8:30pm

Simply tell us how many members of your household will be coming to the Street Party and bring this commemorative guide with you (no need to cut the voucher out) and hand it to a member of the team running the BBQ
